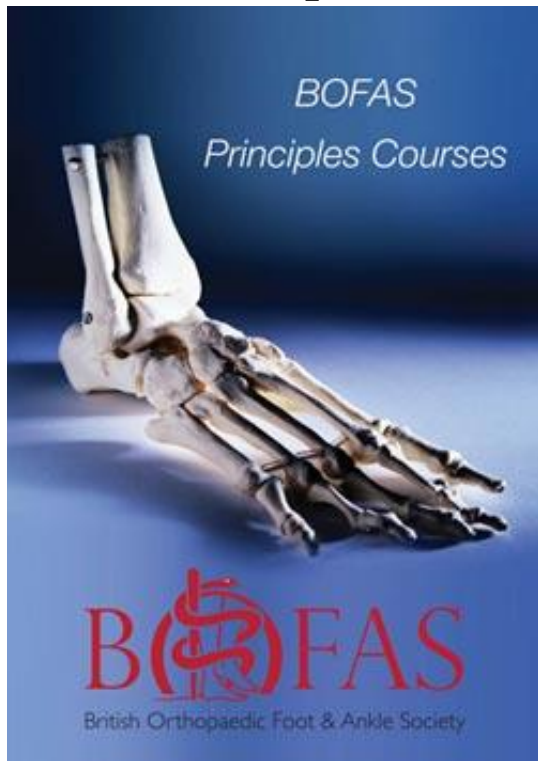


# BOFAS Principles of Foot & Ankle Surgery - Dunfermline (Course now Full)
