DESCRIPTION AND AIMS	We are a team of 3 full time Foot and Ankle surgeons within an Orthopaedic department of 20 Consultants. The Foot and Ankle unit have the support of a specialist Foot and Ankle ANP, podiatrists, 2 MSK radiologist and deanery appointed orthopaedic trainees.
	We offer experience in the full complement of foot and ankle conditions including deformity correction, neuromuscular disorders, diabetic foot, complex charcot reconstruction and ankle arthroplasty. Depending on experience the fellow will be offered supervised and independent clinics and theatre sessions. We also offer trauma exposure focusing on general orthopaedic and complex foot and ankle trauma. Elective procedures are performed in our dedicated cold site where we conduct both our inpatient and daycase surgery. There is a weekly MDT diabetic foot clinic. We also hold a regular combined foot and ankle clinic to discuss complex cases. The post will involve an on call commitment to support the fellows general orthopaedic experience.
	In addition to their clinical duties the fellow is expected to conduct research and participate in audit and publication. They will also be encouraged attend and present at the regional North West Foot and Ankle meetings.
