DESCRIPTION AND AIMS	<p>This is a 12-month fixed term appointment to the Hampshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust to work as a post CCT Foot &amp; Ankle Fellow, under the supervision of two fellowship trained Orthopaedic Consultants (Mr Robin Elliot &amp; Mr Daniel Marsland) who are sub-specialised in foot and ankle surgery.</p> <p><b>The successful applicant will be expected to:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Contribute to the provision of a comprehensive, high-quality foot and ankle service at the Trust</b></li> <li><b>2. Deliver clinical sessions in out-patients and theatres</b></li> <li><b>3. Take a lead role in the department's current foot and ankle research portfolio</b></li> <li><b>4. Assist in the teaching and training of junior surgical colleagues and allied health professionals</b></li> </ol>

	<p>The fellow will be expected to achieve competencies and objectives during the post that will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assessment, investigation and diagnosis of all foot and ankle conditions in out-patients</li> <li>Hallux valgus surgery</li> <li>Lesser toe surgeries</li> <li>Fusions (1<sup>st</sup> MTPJ, midfoot, hindfoot)</li> <li>Ankle arthroscopy</li> <li>Ankle ligament reconstruction</li> <li>Total ankle replacement</li> <li>Achilles tendon repair (minimally invasive)</li> <li>Achilles tendon debridement / reattachment</li> <li>Foot and ankle trauma</li> <li>Assessment and treatment of paediatric foot &amp; ankle conditions</li> </ul> <p>(Extra sessions delivered as part of the trauma on call service can be discussed at the time of appointment)</p> <p><u>Timetable</u></p> <p>The fellowship timetable adheres to BOFAS guidelines and will involve theatre sessions with associated outpatient clinics and patient related administration. The postholder is expected to contribute a significant amount of time to research working with Mr Elliot and Mr Marsland.</p>
