Norwich Foot and Ankle Fellowship

The aim of the fellowship is to prepare an orthopaedic surgeon, who is accredited or within one year of completed training, to the level of independent practice in orthopaedics, specialising in foot and ankle surgery.

The fellow will work with 3 consultants covering all aspects of foot and ankle practice including trauma, diabetic foot and neuromuscular adult conditions.

Participation in ongoing audit and research is supported and expected. Additional funding is available for these activities. The fellow is responsible for maintaining the PROMS database.

The fellow has an on call commitment with the registrar trauma on call.
