Oxford Fellowship in Foot and Ankle Surgery

The Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre is a teaching hospital in the Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. It provides a service for the clinical management of all musculoskeletal problems, with Orthopaedics, Rheumatology, Sports Medicine, Rehabilitation and Medical Imaging. There are 196 beds on 5 orthopaedic wards, the bone infection unit, HDU, 8 operating theatres and a day surgery unit.

The Fellowship aims to develop an individual to a point of overall competence as a specialist Foot & Ankle Surgeon. The Fellow will usually in turn be attached to Mr Sharp/ Mr Brown, with sub-specialty experience in ankle replacement, adolescent Orthopaedics, neuro-muscular disorders; and then Mr Rogers/ Mr Loizou with additional experience in the management of the complex diabetic foot.

The Fellow usually has completed a previous Fellowship elsewhere and is encouraged to undertake operating lists independently, in final preparation for Consultant practice.

The Fellow will be expected to participate in audit and research. They regularly lecture and examine the Medical students. The Fellow co-ordinates the monthly journal club.

The full-time post is for 6 months, but is often extended by mutual agreement to 12 months. The Fellow is now resident on-call for the elective site (1 in 13 approx). Salary scale: MN37 plus on call supplement.
