

The Windsor Foot and Ankle Fellowship is a nationally recognised 6 month post-CCT training post based at Heatherwood and Wexham Park Hospitals in Berkshire, part of the Frimley Health NHS Trust. The fellowship has been run by Callum Clark and Raman Dega since 2007 and has an excellent reputation for preparing senior trainees for life as a consultant foot and ankle surgeon. Both Mr Clark and Mr Dega are BOFAS committee members and keen educators. The fellow is expected to take responsibility for the smooth running and management of the Foot and Ankle unit, and to undertake both supervised and independent clinics and operating lists. The post includes participation in the Diabetic foot MDT and involvement in complex trauma cases at Wexham Park hospital in addition to the largely elective workload at Heatherwood hospital. A wide range of elective work is undertaken, from forefoot surgery to complex/revision ankle arthroplasty. Time is also allocated for study and research, which is also an important element of the post, as is attendance at a local complex case X-ray meeting, monthly clinical governance and 2-monthly clinical conference. Study leave is available upon application and remuneration is in line with the National salary scale with appropriate banding payment. A full job description is available upon request.
