DESCRIPTION AND AIMS	The Wrightington Hospital Fellowships in Foot and Ankle Surgery have been running for over 10 years. We have 2 posts available every year, both of which would be optimally suitable for peri- or post-CCT Speciality Registrars coming towards the end of their training. Both Fellowships provide an excellent opportunity for comprehensive clinical and surgical experience in all aspects of Foot and Ankle surgery. The Team at Wrightington Hopsital perform the largest number of ankle replacements within the UK (around 75/year) and around an additional 400 major hindfoot operations per year. There is a very strong sports surgery interest, together with the opportunity for specialist foot and ankle trauma and diabetic foot surgery experience. The post holders will have x3 clinics and x4 operating theatre sessions per week. There is an additional x1 research session per week. Publication is expected during the year and the successful candidates have a strong track record on delivering this. Similarly, the post holders should be aim to be present research work both nationally and internationally. There are monthly MDT meetings and an additional regional meeting every 3 months. On call commitment is optional.
